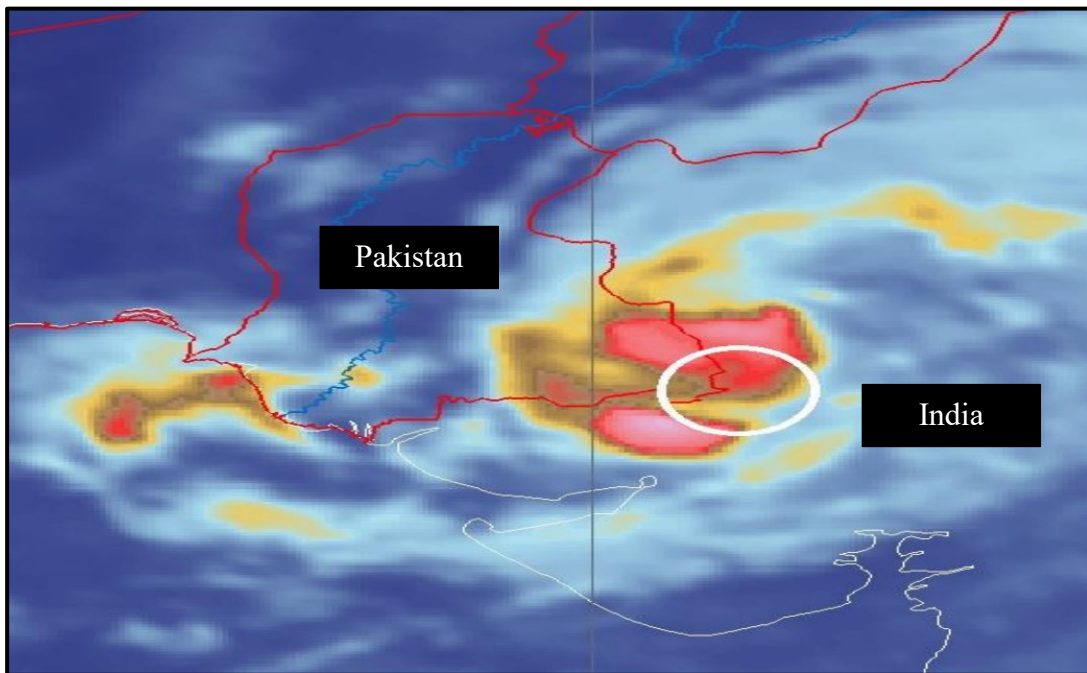

Subject: **Cyclonic Storm "BIPARJOY" – Depression over**

Reference: *NDMA TC-Advisory No.F.2(E)/2023-NDMA(TC-Alert-XXVI) dated 16 Jun 2023*

In continuation of above referred TC Advisory, PMD has issued a Press Release (**Annex A**) updating that Cyclonic Storm "**BIPARJOY**" has **weakened into a depression and now lies over Southeast Tharparkar & Southwest Rajasthan (India)** with maximum sustained surface winds of **30-40 km/h**. The system is likely to move further Eastward and weaken into a low-pressure area over Rajasthan (India).



2. **Possible Impacts**. Following impacts may affect areas of Pakistan while under the influence of this system: -

- a. More rains / thunderstorms with few heavy falls accompanied by gusty winds of 30-40 km/h in Districts Tharparkar, Umerkot, and Parts of Badin on 17 June (today).
- b. Rain-dust / thunderstorms expected in Districts Thatta, Sujawal and Mirpurkhas.
- c. Fishermen of Balochistan may resume their activities from 17 June (today).
- d. Fishermen of Sindh may resume their activities from 18 June.

3. **PDMA Sindh / DDMAs**. Please ensure that following actions are undertaken in affected areas: -

- a. Detailed report on inundation in affected areas and timeline for recession.
- b. Ensure continued provision of essential relief goods i.e. food, water and medical support.
- c. Detailed assessment of losses, damages and roads network in affected areas.
- b. Provision of early recovery assistance for cyclone affected areas.
- c. Development of Rehabilitation Plan for cyclone affected areas.

Depression over Southeast Pakistan and Southwest Rajasthan

The Cyclonic Storm (CS) “BIPARJOY” over Rann of Kutch (India) and adjoin and adjoining southeast Pakistan (Tharparker) moved further northeastward during last 12 hours, converted into a Depression and now lies over southwest Rajasthan (India) and southeast Pakistan (Tharparker) near Latitude 24.4°N & Longitude 71.2°E. The associated maximum sustained surface winds are 30-40 Km/hour gusting 50 Km/hour. The system is likely to move further eastward and weaken into a low-pressure area over Rajasthan (India).

This is the final bulletin in this regard.

Possible Impacts:

- More rain-thunderstorms with few heavy falls & accompanied with gusty winds of 30-40 Km/hour gusting 50 Km/hour expected in Tharparker, Umerkot and parts of Badin districts today.
- Rain-thunderstorms expected in Thatta, Sujawal & Mirpurkhas districts.
- **Fishermen of Balochistan can resume their activities from today and those of Sindh from tomorrow.**
